PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The original school was built in 1948 with additions built in 1955 and 1999.

The school building is a two storey structure and designed in the Early Modern architectural style.

The school is arranged along a central corridor. Classrooms are interconnected for team teaching opportunities. Windows are generously sized to maximize natural light.

The school gym was seismically upgraded in 2008.
