PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The original school was built in 1910 as a two room frame building (known as “Wilson Road School”).

Various additions and internal renovations were completed throughout the decades. The current school facility is a three storey brick structure with two smaller detached out buildings and a separate gym building.

The school building was seismically upgraded in 1997. Heritage elements that were restored include the brick facade, exterior and interior building details and window design.

New elements included the installation of an elevator, the expansion of the existing gym, the re-configuration of the some of the classrooms, the multi-purpose space and internal circulation areas.
