PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The original school structure was built in 1947 with additions constructed in 1950 and 2011. The school was designed in the Early Modern architectural style and consists of one and three storey classroom blocks and a gymnasium.

The use of glass blocks on the building's exterior create a glazed wall facing east and west and bay windows maximize access to natural light.

The school building was seismically upgraded in 2009. The exterior and interior layout was retained and not significantly impacted by the seismic upgrade.

Currently, a one classroom addition is being constructed to accommodate full day kindergarten programming.
