PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

The original school structure was built in 1912. A fire destroyed the part of the original school building.

The central school facility was rebuilt in 1946 with new gym/auditorium. In 1950 the addition of west wing was built. In 1962, another fire damaged portions of the school which were repaired the same year. Further additions were completed in 1998 and 2002.

Portions of the school were seismically upgraded in 2003 and the remaining components were completed in 2009. The upgrade project also included new architectural finishes, mechanical and electrical systems.
