PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

This replacement school was official opened in 2000. The school has a Contemporary design with the main school entrance opening onto a three storey central atrium.

The natural light in the atrium creates a sense of openness and makes this space the heart of the school. The atrium has many functions including the school cafeteria during lunch time, assembly space for special events and informal study space.

The school has a fully furnished and equipped auditorium. The auditorium is designed in the style of a professional theatre making it well-suited for school's drama, vocal, and instrumental music programs.

Classrooms are clustered by subject. Each department shares a teaching preparation area.
